

GENERAL SHOW GUIDELINES & RENCRAFT POLICIES

APPLICATION PROCESS & JURYING

1. Renaissance Craftables' juried fine art & craft show application process is open to all artists who design and produce their own work.
2. All shows are juried by a committee of artisans and businesspeople.
3. Previous acceptance in a show does not guarantee re-acceptance into that or any other show promoted by Renaissance Craftables.
4. Your booth and work should be consistent with the images sent for jurying. Only the category of work in your submitted images can be displayed at the show. If you bring other work with you to a show, we reserve the right to ask you to not display the work and/or to leave the show.
5. Our due diligence with regard to any "buy/sell" vendors includes internet research, studio visits and input from experienced artisans.
6. Our shows do not allow imported items, kits, commercial or manufactured items nor any direct service nor multi-level marketing companies.
7. Booth fees are deposited upon acceptance.
8. For PR purposes, we may use your images if you check the appropriate Entry Thingy box.

SET-UP / BREAKDOWN

9. Artists must provide a tent with detachable sides and leg weights at a minimum of 20# per leg,; and artists are expected to properly secure their booth and any displayed work to ensure the safety of the public and other nearby booths.
10. Set up will not begin until vehicles are fully unloaded and moved to approved parking areas.
11. Our shows do not allow for early breakdown.
12. For everyone's safety, no vehicles are allowed in any show area for breakdown until local police and/or festival organizers give permission.

WEATHER

13. Our shows are "rain or shine" and all artists are expected to be on site at set up time; however we would never force an artist to set up in dangerous weather and risk ruining their work.
14. In extreme conditions, a show may be cancelled due to weather-related problems with no refunds.

DURING THE SHOW

15. You, the artist, must be present at the show.
16. Artist booths must be open and staffed during all regular show hours. Artists arriving late, leaving before closing, or breaking down during show hours may be refused entrance into future shows.
17. Professional behavior must be exhibited at all times. We reserve the right to remove any artist (with no refund) who may behave in an unprofessional, inappropriate or illegal manner.
18. Artists are responsible for keeping their area clear of trash during show hours and at breakdown.
19. Booth sitting is available at all of our shows.

SECURITY

20. Although we provide overnight security at our shows, Renaissance Craftables is not responsible for damage, theft or loss of an artist's work, personal property or display materials.

CANCELLATIONS

21. We have a "no refund policy" in the case of cancellations. Any partial credits are decided on a case-by-case basis.

OTHER

22. It is the responsibility of all artists to comply with local, state and federal revenue and tax laws.
23. A \$15.00 fee will be charged for all checks returned for insufficient funds.
