

VINELAND SHOW GUIDELINES & GENERAL RENCRAFT POLICIES

APPLICATION PROCESS & JURYING

1. Renaissance Craftables' juried fine art & craft show application process is open to all artists and crafters who design and produce their own work.
2. For the Vineland show, applications from antique, collectible, and vintage sellers will also be accepted.
3. This show will be juried by a committee of artisans and businesspeople.
4. Previous acceptance in a show does not guarantee re-acceptance into that or any other show promoted by Renaissance Craftables.
5. Your booth and work/items should be consistent with the images sent for jurying. Only the category of work in your submitted images can be displayed at the show. If you bring other work or items with you to a show, we reserve the right to ask you to not display the work/items and/or to leave the show.
6. This show will not accept imported items (unless a bona fide "collectible"), kits, commercial or manufactured items, nor any direct service nor multi-level marketing companies.
7. Jury fees are deposited upon receipt with a printed, signed application form. Booth fees are deposited upon acceptance into the show.
8. For PR purposes, we may use your images if you check the appropriate Entry Thingy box.

SET-UP / BREAKDOWN

9. Participants in this show must use a tent with detachable sides; and leg weights at a minimum of 20# per leg. You are expected to properly secure your booth and any displayed work or items to ensure the safety of the public and other nearby booths.
10. Set up should not begin until your vehicle is fully unloaded and moved to an approved parking area.
11. Our shows do not allow for early breakdown. If you break down early, RenCrafts reserves the right to not accept you into future shows.

WEATHER

12. This show has a Rain Date and all participants are expected to show up on the Rain Date.
13. In extreme conditions, a show may be cancelled due to weather-related problems with no refunds.

DURING THE SHOW

14. For artists and crafters, YOU, the artist, must be present at the show. For antique, collectible and vintage dealers, whomever submits the application form must be present at the show.
15. Your booth must be open and staffed during all show hours. Participants arriving late, leaving before closing, or breaking down during show hours may be refused entrance into future shows.
17. Professional behavior must be exhibited at all times. RenCrafts reserves the right to remove any participant who may behave in an unprofessional, inappropriate or illegal manner.
18. Participants are responsible for keeping their area clear of trash during show hours and at breakdown.
19. Booth sitting will be available at this show.

SECURITY

20. Renaissance Craftables is not responsible for damage, theft or loss of any artisan work or antique, collectible or vintage items, personal property or display materials.

CANCELLATIONS

21. RenCrafts has a "no refund policy" in the case of cancellations. Any partial or future show credits are decided on a case-by-case basis.

OTHER

22. It is the responsibility of all participants to comply with local, state and federal revenue and tax laws.
23. A \$25.00 fee (per check) will be assessed to you for any check/s returned for insufficient funds.
