

APPLICATION PROCESS & JURING

1. Artists applying to a Renaissance Craftables' show must design and produce their own work.
2. All shows are juried by a committee of artists and businesspeople.
3. Previous acceptance in a show does not guarantee re-acceptance into that or any other show promoted by Renaissance Craftables.
4. Your booth and work should be consistent with images sent for juring. Only the category of work shown in your submitted images can be displayed at the show. If you bring other work with you to a show, we reserve the right to ask you to not display it and/or to leave the show.
5. Our shows do not allow imported items, "buy/sell," commercial or manufactured items including those made with kits, molds or patterns, nor any direct service nor multi-level marketing company products.
6. Our due diligence with regard to any "buy/sell" vendors includes internet research, studio visits and input from experienced artisans.
7. We ask that your items do not use trademarked images or symbols unless the design is of the artists' own creation, or the images are in the public domain. We reserve the right to ask you to remove any such items from your booth.
7. Booth fee must be provided upon acceptance into a show unless otherwise noted.

SET-UP / BREAKDOWN

8. Artists must provide a tent with detachable sides and leg weights at a minimum of 30# per leg (40# preferred); and artists are expected to properly secure their booth and any displayed work to ensure the safety of the public and other nearby booths.
9. Set up will not begin until vehicles are fully unloaded and moved to approved parking areas.
10. Our shows do not allow for early breakdown.
11. For everyone's safety, no vehicles are allowed in any show area for set-up or breakdown until local police and/or festival organizers give permission.

SECURITY

12. Although we provide overnight security at our shows, Renaissance Craftables is not responsible for damage, theft or loss of an artist's work, personal property or display materials.

WEATHER

13. Our shows are "rain or shine" and all artists are expected to be on site at set up time; however we would never force an artist to set up in dangerous weather and risk ruining their work.
14. In extreme conditions, a show may be cancelled due to weather-related problems with no refunds.

DURING THE SHOW

15. You, the artist, must be present at the show. Failure to attend a show may result in you not being accepted into a future show of ours.
16. Artist booths must be open and staffed during all regular show hours. Artists arriving late, leaving before closing, or breaking down during show hours may be refused entrance into future shows.
17. Professional behavior must be exhibited at all times. We reserve the right to remove any artist (with no refund) or refuse the artist entry into a future show if the artist behaves in an unprofessional, inappropriate or illegal manner.
18. Artists are responsible for keeping their area clear of trash during show hours and at breakdown.

CANCELLATIONS

20. We have a "no refund policy" if a show is cancelled. Any partial credit toward a future show is decided on a case-by-case basis.

ARTIST RESPONSIBILITIES

21. It is the responsibility of the artist to comply with all federal, state and local revenue and sales tax regulations; and to procure booth/vendor/event liability insurance for each show they participate in.
